## Perinatal palliative birth planning

A perinatal palliative care program that is the first of its kind in the region is now available through Midwest Fetal Care Center and Minnesota Perinatal Physicians.

We provide specialized support to expectant families facing a potentially life-threatening or life-limiting fetal diagnosis. This support is often referred to as palliative care, and it includes the services of experts in multiple disciplines, working together to meet each family's unique needs. Care is individualized to support families throughout pregnancy and after bitth

Team members from this multidisciplinary approach may include: maternal-fetal medicine specialists, pediatric palliative care providers, advanced practice registered nurses (APRNs), genetic counselors, fetal care coordinators, clinical ethicist, and social workers.
